Did you know that sometimes God gets angry? It's not like we get angry, it's getting angry at what they were doing. The Israelites were His children and He wanted them to listen to him, He loved them! But they didn't love him anymore.

So God sent Zechariah, the son of the priest who had died. He gave the king a message from God.
